Formed in 2011, UCOR is an environmental cleanup contractor for the Department of Energy (DOE) Office of Environmental Management (EM) at the Oak Ridge Reservation in Oak Ridge, Tennessee. UCOR is an AECOM-led partnership with Jacobs. The cleanup team also includes small business partner, RSI EnTech, LLC.



Our Mission at the Oak Ridge Reservation

To achieve DOE's mission, UCOR will demolish all buildings and structures slated for cleanup at the East Tennessee Technology Park (ETTP). Additionally, the majority of contaminated soils will be removed and a final strategy for the protection of groundwater in place. Completion of these activities will enable realization of DOE's ultimate vision for the site as a multi-use industrial site.

As ETTP cleanup wraps up, UCOR prepares DOE and the workforce for the next phase of cleanup on the Oak Ridge Reservation—relocating people, equipment and services closer to future cleanup locations; designing and constructing facilities to treat and store future cleanup waste; and reducing risks in facilities awaiting final demolition.
